HOW TO WRITE IN A CANDIDATE

Example: James Ellison for State Treasurer

1

Find the race on your ballot

Look for the write-in line below the office name (e.g. "State Treasurer").

2

Fill in the oval completely

Use black or blue ink. Fill the oval next to the write-in line.

3

Write the candidate's name

Print the name clearly on the line next to the oval.
